Pool Etiquette: Please make sure all babies and toddlers wear swim diaper protection.

No glass containers or breakable objects are permitted in the pool area.

Please do NOT open the gate for people you do not know; non-residents are trying to use <u>your</u> pool and facilities. Report lost pool cards to the office.

Members may bring up to <u>four</u> guests to the pool; the members **must** be present with their guests. Children 16 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Watering Restrictions: During daylight saving time, homes with odd number address may water Wednesday & Saturday; homes with even number address Thursday and Sunday. Water as needed only and not between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.

R A R C Schedule: The RARC (Residential Architectural Review Committee) meets the <u>second</u> Wednesday of each month at 10 a.m. If you are planning any work to the exterior of your house or property, please complete an application and drop it off at the office prior to the next meeting. Applications may be obtained online at our website or at the office.

Approved applications are valid for six months.
