<u>Watering Restrictions:</u> St. Johns River Water Management District's mandatory watering restrictions are based on the time of the year and whether the address is an odd or even number. Daylight saving time ends **November 3, 2024. Lawn watering is reduced to once a week.** Homes with <u>odd number address may water Saturday; homes with even number address may water Sunday.

Water only when needed and not between 10 a.m. and 4 p.m.</u>

Parking: If you have company visiting and too many cars to fit in the driveway, you may park at the clubhouse once you have obtained permission and a parking pass from the office. Remember, there is no parking on the street overnight.

Per the Fire Marshall, there is <u>NO</u> parking in the area leading up to the portico of the Clubhouse, except for drop off and pickup.

RARC Schedule: The RARC (Residential Architectural Review Committee) meets the second Wednesday of each month at 10 a.m. If you are planning any work to the exterior of your house or property, please complete an application and drop it off at the office prior to the next meeting. Applications may be obtained online or at the office.

Approved applications are valid for six months.

Signs: Political signs are NOT allowed in Countryside. If displayed, they will be picked up. The only sign allowed is one (1) "For Sale" sign in front of the residence. See Article III Section 3.7 of the Countryside covenants and restrictions.
